

#### GETTING TO MARBACH CASTLE

Marbach Castle is located off the beaten track on the shores of Lake Constance, and yet it can readily be reached by plane, train or car.

#### **Bv Train**

The nearest German railway station, Radolfzell (10 miles from the Castle) can be reached with the InterRegio train via Frankfurt, Heidelberg or with the EC/IC/ICE trains with connection in Mannheim (ICE) and Offenburg.

Stein am Rhein on the Swiss side of the border (5 miles from the Castle) offers train connections to Schaffhausen, Winterthur, Zurich and to the international Zurich Airport.

#### **Shuttle Service**

Upon request we can arrange to have you picked up and taken to Marbach Castle by shuttle bus either from one of the nearby railway stations or from one of the airports (Zurich, Stuttgart, Friedrichshafen).

## By Car - from Frankfurt/Stuttgart

On the A81 in the direction of Singen, continue at the Kreuz Hegau junction toward Konstanz/Radolfzell (B33), then exit at Singen/Steisslingen/Moos. Continue following the signs for Moos.

After Moos, Iznang, Horn, Gaienhofen and Hemmenhofen you will find Marbach Castle on the left side of the road, about half a mile outside the village of Hemmenhofen.

# By Car - from Munich

Take the A8 to Ulm, and from there the B30 through Biberach and Ravensburg to Meersburg where the car ferry will get you to Konstanz. From there follow the road signs to Singen until the exit for Radolfzell (B33). Through Radolfzell follow the signs to Stein am Rhein (CH).

After Moos, Iznang, Horn, Gaienhofen and Hemmenhofen you will find Marbach Castle on the left side of the road, about half a mile outside the village of Hemmenhofen.

## By Car - from Zurich, the shortest way, via Andelfingen

On the A1 towards Winterthur, take the exit for Schaffhausen/ Henggart, then on the A4 exit at Kleinandelfingen/Stein am Rhein/Ossingen. After Ossingen, Waltalingen, Etzwilen and Kaltenbach you will reach Stein am Rhein.

At the beginning of the town follow the signs for Öhningen (D). Cross the bridge over the river Rhine, then follow the Transit signs, and after that the signs for Radolfzell (D).

After crossing the border proceed through Öhningen and Wangen until you reach Marbach Castle on the right side of the road, about half a mile outside the village of Wangen.

## By Car - from Zurich, the fastest way, via Frauenfeld

On the A1 in the direction of St. Gallen/Winterthur-Ohringen, continue towards Konstanz/Kreuzlingen/Frauenfeld (A7). On the A7 take the exit Frauenfeld-West. Turn left at the first stop sign and proceed under the motorway, then continue straight on after you cross the intersection with the traffic lights and follow the signs for Stein am Rhein, which will take you through Weinigen, Herdern and Eschenz.

Before you reach Stein am Rhein bear to the right, following the the signs for Öhningen (D). Cross the bridge over the river Rhine, then follow the Transit signs, and after that the signs for Radolfzell (D).

After crossing the border proceed through Öhningen and Wangen until you reach Marbach Castle on the right side of the road, about half a mile outside the village of Wangen.
